



## **Longest Journey on a Personal Watercraft(Aquabike)(Jetski)**

### **Evidence Required**

1. Cover letter (summarizing the details of your record attempt – when, where, who and which record– as well as its precise measurements. Please also detail what you are including in your evidence).
2. Printouts of satellite tracking data and GPS Data.
3. Video footage of the record attempt on DVD .(Edited with subtitles)(Video footage must show the date and time on the video.)
5. High-quality labelled colour photographs of your record attempt.(Show time and date info from the camera on the photographs.)
6. Specific evidence (as requested in the Guidelines sent to you for your record attempt): log books, and charts, a list of all stewards/team members (complete with profession, address and phone numbers), and so on.

Failure to provide any of the material listed here and in the Guidelines document may result in your claim being rejected, so please check the documentation before you submit it.

You can also send any other materials that you would like us to review, or to share as back-up evidence, such as media coverage generated by your record attempt (newspaper articles, news videos, etc). Note: these cannot be used to replace any of the above.

### **1. COVER LETTER**

This must outline the details of the record that you are claiming and describe the evidence you are submitting. This must also outline any specific incidents during the event – for example a mechanical failure, an injury or extreme weather conditions – and any other details you think relevant to your claim or which you wish to share with us.

You must also submit the full name, postal address, telephone number and e-mail address of the record holder, so that these details are correct in our records database.
